Executive Summary

The meeting was a huge success with record attendance and an amazing program featuring Dr. Kristen DeAngelis (UMass) and Dr. Anne A. Madden (Lachancea LLC.) as our two NEMPET Speakers.

In total, we had 65 attendees, 32 of whom were students (22 undergrads), from 27 different institutions. The program included 17 excellent talks and 24 posters.
