Executive Summary

We had another successful meeting this year. The program featured Dr. Kathryn Milligan McClellan (UConn) as our NEMPET Speaker, and a great program provided by all the attendees.

In total, we had 42 attendees, 23 of whom were students (18 undergrads), from 17 different institutions. The program included 10 excellent talks, a workshop on microscopy, and 18 posters.
